As of now the situation is mainly critical for the pharmacies which are closed to get back open. Medical Needs Shelters have only a small population and they are accessing a pharmacy close by, there are a number of open pharmacies in Tuscaloosa. Small communities are a different story and there are reports of temporary locations in some. There are about 600 people in MASS shelters and no reports of critical needs as of now.

If there is a call for pharmacists volunteers I will get the word out asap. If you want to help you can volunteer at the Red Cross for now. Other places to contact are the local EMA in the counties that are affected.
